The Bali Process Regional Support Office (RSO) was established in 2012 to provide technical support to the Bali Process Members and to strengthen regional cooperation on refugee protection and international migration, including human trafficking and people smuggling. The RSO is the only cooperation mechanism of its kind in the region.

from Bali Process members and other key stakeholders to develop **practical initiatives** that address people smuggling, trafficking in persons and related transnational crime.



The *Bali Process on People Smuggling, Trafficking in Persons and Related Transnational Crime* (Bali Process) was established in 2002 to focus on long-term strategies to address the crimes of people smuggling, trafficking in persons and other related transnational crime in Asia and the Pacific.
