BACKGROUND INFORMATION

RSO ROSTER OF EXPERTS - OVERVIEW

- The Roster comprises selected experts on migration management and international protection, who are officials from governments, international organizations and civil society, including NGOs.
- It serves as a tool for capacity building of interested Bali Process members by making available legal, policy and operational expertise.
- Experts are nominated by Bali Process Members and Observers.

SELECTION CONSIDERATIONS FOR NOMINATIONS

- All experts are expected to have an appropriate level of practical and technical credentials, including relevant work experience.
- In nominating experts, nominators are encouraged to consider the ***minimum selection considerations*** outlined in the ***Information Sheet***.
- Nominators can nominate any number of experts from government, international organizations, NGOs and/or academia.
- The roster will note which government and/or organization nominated the expert. Nominators vouch for the expert's ability to deliver expertise of a high quality in a timely manner to the satisfaction of stakeholders.

EXPERT STATUS

- Experts are available and authorized to conduct short term technical and capacity building missions or activities upon request from Bali Process members.
- Experts are independent of the RSO when carrying out activities arising from the expert's association with the roster (ie. experts are not accredited by the RSO, and do not work formally on behalf of the RSO).
- An expert's inclusion on the roster is for one year. However, inclusion is revocable by the RSO at any time upon reasonable request from the expert or from nominator/s.
- Inclusion on the roster does not guarantee or constitute an offer of employment.
